Application Process

1. Apply to PULSE
2. Application is Reviewed by PULSE (to determine whether to schedule interview)
3. Conduct a Phone/On-site Interview with PULSE
 - PULSE will contact you to schedule a phone/on-site interview (based upon location)
 - Interviews typically last between 30-45 mins and conducted by PULSE Executive Director
4. Receive Offer from PULSE to Join Program (become a PULSE participant)
5. Sign Letter of Commitment/Covenant and Agree to Join Program (include \$100 refundable housing deposit)
6. Conduct Site Visit to Pittsburgh for Placement Interviews
 - PULSE offers on-site interviews to participants based on the match of their skill sets and giftedness to the needs of specific placements
 - Participants are encouraged to develop a short list of potential work placements of interest
 - Placement Interviews are typically scheduled all on one day, sometimes two (during the summer)
 - Participants are encouraged and welcome to stay at the PULSE house (current participant will be assigned to be host)
7. Review and Decide on Offer from Placement with Executive Director
6. Arrive at PULSE Orientation
